Eligibility Criteria

Eligible Participants

Students registered in TUC

Recent graduates may participate in a traineeship. Recent graduates must be selected during their last year of study, and must carry out and complete their traineeship abroad within one year of obtaining their graduation.

TUC 2nd cycle applicants must be enrolled at least at the 2nd semester of their studies in order to carry out their traineeship the following year.

They must hold a diploma/proof of competency (at least B1) at the language of work

They must have a written approval of their thesis supervisor

Participants having already participated at the Erasmus+ program before, they have low priority

ELIGIBLE COUNTRIES

All the 28 making part of the EU + Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, FYROM, Turkey (The country of the sending Institutions are never eligible)

Eligible hosts

Eligible Organisations	The receiving organisation can be: V any public or private organisation active in the labour market or in the fields of education, training and youth. For example, such organisation can be: - a public or private, a small, medium or large enterprise (including social enterprises); - a public body at local, regional or national level; - a social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, craft/professional associations and trade unions; - a research institute; - a foundation; - a school/institute/educational centre (at any level, from pre-school to upper secondary education, and including vocational education and adult education); V a non-profit organisation, association, NGO; V a body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services; V a Programme Country HEI awarded with an ECHE.

Number of partcipants	Relevant with the annual funding. The funds and available places are divided equally per School.
Evaluation	By the appointed Erasmus Academic Coordiantor of each School, based on the criteria set at the "Erasmus Assessment Regulation" (as approved by the Senators of the Institution), which guarantees transparency, objectivity, fairness and equal treatment
Runners up	✓Apply again ✓Participate as zero grant students
Duration of the traineeship	3 months (possibility of extension depending on the remaining funds and the size of the demand)
Calls for traineeship	Twice a year: V 1 March - 31 May 2018 for undertaking a traineeship from October 2018 until 31st August 2019 V 1 October - 30t October 2018 for undertaking a traineeship from December 2018 until 31st August 2019
